



The University of Southern California Department of Public Safety is providing this notice of a criminal incident that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding a similar crime or provide information to solve this crime. This notice is also intended to meet the requirements of the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistic Act of 1998.

ROBBERY

Incident #1:

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE: June 2, 2009 at 9:30 PM

LOCATION: 2700 Block of Ellendale (Off Campus)

REPORTED OFFENSE: The complainant was walking alone southbound on Ellendale when the suspect approached him from the opposite direction. The suspect walked up to the complainant, displayed a weapon and demanded the complainant's property. The complainant complied. The suspect then left the location southbound on foot with complainant's property.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION (provided by complainant):

Male Black, 6 feet 2 inches tall, 220lbs, heavy build, black hoodie type sweatshirt, and black pants.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: None seen.

Incident #2:

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE: June 3, 2009 9:44 AM

LOCATION: 1120 W. 27th Street (Off Campus)

REPORTED OFFENSE: The complainant was walking eastbound on the south sidewalk of 27th St. when the suspect approached him on foot from the front, displayed the handle of a firearm in his right front trouser pocket and demanded complainant's property. Out of fear for his safety, the complainant handed the suspect his property. The suspect then took the complainant's property and fled on foot westbound 27th Street from Hoover Street.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION (provided by complainant) Male Black, approximately 20-23 years old, approximately 6 feet tall, with a fade/tapered hair cut, wearing a dark hooded jacket and dark pants. The suspect may also be carrying a large shoulder bag across his left shoulder.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: None seen.

TAKE A STAND AGAINST ROBBERY

- **Always walk on busy streets** - Avoid walking alone. Use Campus Cruiser (213)740-4911.
- Avoid using cell phones or MP3 players while walking – Suspects target phones and other items in plain view.
- **Do not carry expensive purses or bags.** Conceal them inside of a larger bag.
- In the event of a robbery, stay calm and comply with the suspect’s demands.
- **After the robbery,** call DPS right away. The first 2 minutes after a crime occurs are critical to law enforcement.
- If you observe a crime in progress, **STAY CALM AND CALL DPS (213)740-4321.**
- **BE A GOOD WITNESS.** Describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as sex, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars. Try to get the license plate if a vehicle is involved.
