



The University of Southern California Department of Public Safety is providing this notice of a criminal incident that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding a similar crime or provide information to solve this crime. This notice is also intended to meet the requirements of the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistic Act of 1998.

ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE: July 26, 2009 at 4:30 AM.

LOCATION: 3800 Block of Figueroa Street (Off Campus).

REPORTED OFFENSE: The Complainant was stopped in his vehicle at a red light when Suspect #1 walked up to him and smashed out his driver's side window with an unknown object, while Suspect #2 stood by. Suspect #1 then demanded that the complainant hand over his vehicle. The complainant, in fear for his safety and losing his vehicle, drove north bound away from the suspects without surrendering his vehicle. The complainant did not see the direction of travel of the suspects after the incident. There was no USC involvement and the report was taken by LAPD officers.

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION (provided by complainant)

Suspect #1: Male Black, 18 to 24 years old, 5'8" tall, 130-140 pounds, shaved head, wearing a blue cap, white t-shirt, baggy blue jeans, and blue shoes.

Suspect #2: Male Black, 18 to 24 years old, 5'8" tall, 130-140 pounds. No further description.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: No vehicle seen.

TAKE A STAND AGAINST ROBBERY

- Always walk on busy streets - Avoid walking alone. Use Campus Cruiser (213)740-4911.
- Avoid using cell phones or MP3 players while walking – Suspects target phones and other items in plain view.
- Do not carry expensive purses or bags. Conceal them inside of a larger bag.
- In the event of a robbery, stay calm and comply with the suspect's demands.
- After the robbery, call DPS right away. The first 2 minutes after a crime occurs are critical to law enforcement.
- If you observe a crime in progress, **STAY CALM AND CALL DPS (213)740-4321.**
- **BE A GOOD WITNESS.** Describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as sex, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars. Try to get the license plate if a vehicle is involved.
