Incident: Robbery Arrest
Date: 3/12/09 at 1220 PM
Location: University Village, 3300 block McClintock Avenue (Off Campus).

Description: A DPS Officer observed a robbery in progress at the University Village. The officer confronted the suspect and learned that the suspect had assaulted the victim (a USC student) and taken his wallet. The suspect attempted to flee from the scene of the crime but was apprehended by other responding DPS officers.

Disposition: The suspect was apprehended after a short foot pursuit by DPS officers. The victim's wallet was recovered at the scene by DPS officers and returned to him. The suspect was arrested and transported to LAPD's Southwest Division where he was booked for Robbery (211 P.C.)
