Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

Incident: Grand Theft Arrest
Date: January 22, 2009, 4:00 PM
Location: USC Leavey Library

Description: On January 22, 2008 at 3:45 pm, a subject entered Leavey Library and stole two unattended laptop computers from two victims who were in the library. While USC DPS officers were investigating the crime at Leavey, a witness, who alerted responding USC DPS officers to the subject that he had observed steal one of the computers, identified the subject. The subject was arrested and taken into custody by USC DPS officers without further incident.

Disposition: All property including the 2-laptop computers that were concealed by the suspect in a stolen backpack was recovered and returned to the two owners of the property. The subject was arrested and transported by USC DPS officers to LAPD Southwest Division, where upon the approval of the watch commander, was booked for PC 487 (A), Grand Theft.
