In an effort to communicate better with the campus community about public safety issues, we are pleased to provide the following Incident Resolution Notice.

Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

Incident: Receiving Stolen Property Arrest & Battery Arrest
Date: July 8, 2009
Location: Toberman and 25th Streets

Description: On July 8, 2009 USCDPS- Special Problems Unit (SPU) Officers and DPS Detectives worked a joint undercover Receiving Stolen Property operation with LAPD detectives and uniformed patrol officers. During the operation, the LAPD undercover officers were able to make contact with two suspects involved in a Battery and Grand Theft of a USC student that occurred on May, 27 2009. During the operation, the officers also recovered evidence from another Grand Theft (Bicycle) that had occurred on April 24, 2009 and from a Residential Burglary that occurred on March 13, 2009 (all involving USC students as the victims).

Disposition: DPS-SPU, DPS Detectives, LAPD Officers and LAPD Detectives arrested 1 suspect for Receiving Stolen Property and arrested 1 suspect for a felony warrant and Battery. Both suspects were transported and booked for the crimes at LAPD Southwest Station Jail. The recovered property is in the process of being returned to the victims.
