In an effort to communicate better with the campus community about public safety issues, we are pleased to provide the following Incident Resolution Notice.

Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

Incident: Burglary from Motor Vehicle (BFMV)

Date: 02/24/09 at approximately 7:25pm

Location: Corner of 37th Place and Vermont Avenue (Off Campus)

Description: A witness reported seeing a suspect break into a parked vehicle and remove the victim's (a USC Student) property. The suspect then ran away. The witness telephoned DPS, gave a suspect description and his last known direction of travel. DPS officers located and detained the suspect a short time later attempting to break into another vehicle also belonging to a student parked on Vermont Avenue. The witness positively identified the suspect as the person responsible for breaking into the parked vehicle.

Disposition: The suspect, who was also a parolee was arrested for Burglary from Motor Vehicle and transported to LAPD Southwest Police Station by DPS officers where he was booked for felony 459 P.C./BFMV.
