In an effort to communicate better with the campus community about public safety issues, we are pleased to provide the following Incident Resolution Notice.

Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

**Incident:** Residential Burglary  
**Date:** 7/20/09 - 12:45 AM to 6:18 AM  
**Location:** Fraternity Row, University Park Campus Area.

**Description:** On the above date between 12:45 AM and 6:18 AM, three residences on Fraternity/Sorority Row were entered by suspect(s) who stole two vehicles and two lap top computers. During the night, USC-DPS Officers stopped and questioned two suspicious subjects in the area.

**Disposition:** As a result of the initial contact by DPS Officers and subsequent follow-up by DPS and LAPD Detectives, a suspect was identified as having been involved in the thefts. That subject was arrested on 7-22-09 while driving one of the stolen vehicles mentioned above. The other stolen vehicle was recovered in the UPC area a short distance from the original crime. This arrest will clear all (3) residential burglaries.
