Incident: Sexual Battery
Date: 09/12/09 at approximately 3:30 PM
Location: 700 Block of Adams Boulevard

Description: The complainant (USC student) reported that she was walking west bound on Adams Boulevard when she was approached from the rear by a male suspect. The suspect then grabbed the complainant's buttocks. In fear, the Complainant turned around and yelled for the suspect to stop. The suspect then ran south bound towards 27th Street.

Disposition: The suspect was located by DPS Officers at 28th Street and Figueroa Boulevard. The suspect was taken into custody by DPS officers and was positively identified by the victim. The suspect was then arrested and booked at LAPD Southwest Station for Sexual Battery.
