In an effort to communicate better with the campus community about public safety issues, we are pleased to provide the following Incident Resolution Notice.

Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

Incident: Strong-Arm Robbery
Date: October 26th, 2009
Location: 900 Block W. Jefferson Blvd.

Description: On October 26th, 2009 a robbery of a USC Student occurred in the 900 block of W. Jefferson Blvd. The victim was knocked to the ground by the suspects and her cellular phone was taken from her. The victim regained composure and followed the suspects, summoning the aid of a nearby Security Ambassador (CSC Security personnel) who contacted DPS and LAPD Officers.

Disposition: USC-DPS officers were on scene in minutes and located the suspects and detained them for further investigation. The two suspects were positively identified by the student and were subsequently booked on suspicion of robbery at LAPD's Southwest Division Station.
