



The University of Southern California Department of Public Safety is providing this notice of a criminal incident that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding a similar crime or provide information to solve this crime. This notice is also intended to meet the requirements of the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistic Act of 1998.

## **ROBBERY**

**DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE:** June 5, 2009 at 9:20 PM

**LOCATION:** 700 block of 28th Street (off campus)

**REPORTED OFFENSE:** Complainants were inside a room of their residence when the suspects entered, simulated a weapon, and demanded the complainants' property. Out of fear for their safety, the complainants complied. The suspects then fled into a waiting vehicle at the rear of the location and left the area.

**SUSPECT DESCRIPTION** (*provided by complainant*):

**Suspect #1:** Male black, 5 foot 10 inches to 5 foot 11 inches tall, 300lbs, 18 to 20 years old, wearing white, shirt, dark pants simulating a weapon (no weapon seen).

**Suspect #2:** Male black, 6 foot tall, 180lbs, wearing a blue baseball cap, blue sweat shirt and blue jeans.

**Suspect #3:** Male black, 5 foot 10 inches tall, 160lbs, wearing a black sweat shirt and blue jeans.

**SUSPECT VEHICLE:** Dark blue four door, Dodge Charger, with custom wheels.

## **TAKE A STAND AGAINST ROBBERY**

- **Avoid leaving your apartment or house unsecured.**
- **Always walk on busy streets** - Avoid walking alone. Use Campus Cruiser (213)740-4911.
- Avoid using cell phones or MP3 players while walking – Suspects target phones and other items in plain view.
- **Do not carry expensive purses or bags.** Conceal them inside of a larger bag.
- In the event of a robbery, stay calm and comply with the suspect's demands.
- **After the robbery**, call DPS right away. The first 2 minutes after a crime occurs are critical to law enforcement.
- If you observe a crime in progress, **STAY CALM AND CALL DPS (213)740-4321.**
- **BE A GOOD WITNESS.** Describe exactly what you observed with as many details as possible. Give complete descriptions such as sex, race, age, height, weight, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars. Try to get the license plate if a vehicle is involved.
