Incident: Robbery Arrest
Date: June 10, 2009
Location: 29th Street and Orchard Av.

Description: On the evening of June 02, 2009, 9:30 PM, at 2700 block of Ellendale Pl., a suspect on foot approached a male student and displayed a weapon and demanded property, the student in fear for his life complied.

Description: On the morning of June 03, 2009, 9:44 AM, at 1120 west 27th Street, a suspect on foot approached a male student and displayed a weapon and demanded property, the student in fear for his life complied.

Description: On the evening of June 07, 2009, 10:05 PM, at 1200 block west 27th Street, a suspect on foot approached a male student and displayed a weapon and demanded property, the student in fear for his life complied.

Disposition: On June 10, 2009 at 1925 hours, DPS officers and LAPD officers on patrol in the area located and detained a suspect matching the description of the perpetrator in the 3 crimes. The students were able to positively identify the suspect. The suspect was subsequently arrested and booked for 211 P.C. Robbery, at LAPD Southwest Division.
