Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

**Incident:** Attempted Robbery  
**Date:** August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009  
**Location:** 36<sup>th</sup> & Vermont

**Description:** On August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009 an attempted robbery of a USC student occurred in the 1100 block of W. 36<sup>th</sup> Place. The victim was able to escape without losing any of his/her belongings and promptly reported the incident to USC-DPS who had several officers on the scene within moments.

**Disposition:** Shortly after the attempted robbery, USC-DPS officers located a person matching the description of the suspect and detained the individual for further investigation. The suspect was positively identified as the suspect and was subsequently booked on suspicion of attempted robbery at LAPD's 77<sup>th</sup> Division Station.
