Re: Incident Resolution Notice (Indecent Exposure)

In an effort to communicate better with the campus community about public safety issues, we are pleased to provide the following Incident Resolution Notice.

Notices of this nature detail instances in which DPS and/or LAPD have been able to bring a resolution to reported illegal acts affecting our community members. We look forward to providing you with more updates of this nature.

Incident: Indecent Exposure
Date: March 5th, 2009 through July 26th, 2009
Location: North University Park Area.

Description: Between March 5th and July 26th, 2009 at least (5) separate incidents involving a male subject exposing himself to female students occurred in the North University Park area. During each occurrence the suspect was described as a male Hispanic in his 20's or 30's and being of average height and weight. USC-DPS Officers conducted frequent patrol checks of the area and questioned and photographed several likely subjects in an attempt to identify the perpetrator. Response strategies were also developed to contain the suspect should another such crime occur.

Disposition: On July 26th, 2009 USC-DPS Officers responded to a reported indecent exposure in the North University Park area and upon arrival, located and detained the described suspect. The witness / victim of this occurrence positively identified the suspect as the one who had just exposed himself. In addition, this subject matched the description of the suspect on the previously reported incidents. USC-DPS detectives are working with LAPD detectives and most likely this arrest will clear all (5) incidents of indecent exposure..
